4. Y gallu i flaenoriaethu dysgwyr ar adegau allweddol, gan gynnwys y rheini o gefndiroedd difreintiedig
5. Cysondeb â fframwaith Llywodraeth Cymru ar gyfer gwneud penderfyniadau, i sefydlu arweiniad i gefnogi mesurau fel pellhau, rheoli presenoldeb a chamau amddiffyn ehangach.

Dear Parents/ Guardians,

I hope you are keeping healthy and safe and continuing to follow the guidelines in responding to the challenge of Coronavirus.

I would like to thank you all for your hard work during the first half term of learning from home. From looking at the children's digital files it's clear that many of you have completed very interesting work.

I would like to share with you what the Education Minister, Kirsty Williams has identified as five guiding principles that will be followed to determine when and how schools return to providing education for most pupils:

1. The safety, and mental, emotional, and physical wellbeing of students and staff
2. Continued contribution to the national effort and strategy to combat the spread of Covid-19
3. Confidence of parents, staff and students - based on evidence and knowledge - so that they can plan ahead
4. Ability to prioritize learners at key times, including those from disadvantaged backgrounds
5. Consistency with the Welsh Government's decision-making framework, to establish guidance to support measures such as distance, attendance management and wider protection measures.

**As you are aware no decision has been made regarding the re-opening of schools at this time and we have no further information to share with you.**

However, we need to continue to PLAN for the time when schools re-open at some point in the future. We have already gathered information from staff to see how many will be able to return to school. The aim of the questionnaire is to get some idea of what you think as parents / guardians. You will naturally have many questions that we would not be able to answer as our plans are dependent on Government guidance. We hope you will be able to answer the questionnaire that will be emailed to you shortly as best as you can with the very limited information you have. The questionnaire is anonymous.

Your responses will help us in planning the return to school sometime in the future. There will be a different questionnaire for each school year so if you have two children in different years you will need to answer both questionnaires. There are only 3 questions in a questionnaire.

Learning from home activities will continue from this week. The work will be set on a digital platform each every week. I encourage everyone to do your best to complete the tasks and return them to the teachers.
